Dear Community Partner

The Boyle Activity Council has been operating a low cost Children's Soccer Program for the past several years (*\$25/child – in some cases free*). The program operates entirely by community resident volunteers who have provided the organization and coaching for an expected 250-275 children this year. When we started this league a few years ago, we had six teams on two nights and about 85 children and now we have grown to 24 teams over four nights and we have added a fifth field time and implemented a team just for girls. This means that more kids get to be part of a team!

This program continues to meet the needs of the community by offering a low cost alternative for families who would not be able to register their children in a regularly priced league. Our non-competitive atmosphere keeps many children coming back who just enjoy playing soccer without the stress of winning and statistics placed on them. Our Annual BBQ continues to grow in size and scope and for many kids it is one of their highlights of the summer. Last year we had around 500 people attend our BBQ.

We are seeking businesses that are interested to 'invest' in the neighbourhood children by sponsoring one or more of the children's teams. Sponsorship cost is \$250.00 per team. The children receive a uniform, with your company's name and logo, 8 weeks of games and a season's end barbeque with awards. Sponsors receive, as a token of our appreciation, a plaque with your team's photo and company name and a jersey if requested.

The past successes have been a tribute to the sponsors and volunteers who have made children a priority in this community. Sponsorship allows families an accessible and affordable activity for their children that they might not otherwise be able to enjoy.
